Justice at Work (formerly Friends of Farmworkers) is a non-profit organization based in Pennsylvania. Our mission is to support low wage workers as they pursue economic and social justice. We provide direct legal services on employment-related matters to workers in Pennsylvania. Many of our clients are migrant and immigrant workers. Our clients work in a variety of industries, such as agriculture, food processing, and landscaping. In addition to direct legal services, we engage in outreach and education, as well as advocacy.

Interns may: assist with client intake; participate in community education and outreach; conduct research and writing and assist attorneys and paralegals with other case and/or advocacy-related matters; observe and participate in meetings with clients, advocacy organizations, and government agencies; and, if possible, observe court proceedings.

Applicants must be able to commit to interning for 10 weeks. In addition, applicants must have:

- Excellent research and writing skills;
- The ability to handle multiple projects at once;
- Initiative, energy, enthusiasm, and a sense of humor;
- Fluency in Spanish; and,
- Experience working with and/ or interviewing survivors preferred
